The Pinnacle is excited to offer NovaNet (a web enabled credit recovery program). This program is intended to accelerate the acquisition of basic knowledge, provide a strong curricular foundation, help prepare students for state and standardized tests, and ultimately improve student achievement while making-up the necessary credits to meet graduation requirements. Unlike other credit recovery programs, NovaNet first gives a pre-test in order to build a custom curriculum around the concepts identified as areas in which the student struggles. This insures students are focusing on the areas of need, rather than just going through a course designed for all.

The tuition for NovaNet is \$140.00 per semester class. With our enrollment request being at an all time high, all Pinnacle High School students will be expected to have all credits made-up before the start of next school in order to maintain their assured seat here at the Pinnacle. We feel this is a great opportunity for your student to get a jump on the credits they need to graduate. \*Transportation will **not** be provided.
